# 53rd International Letter Writing Competition

The Malawi Communications Regulatory Authority (MACRA), in collaboration with the Universal Postal Union (UPU), is inviting young Malawian learners to the 53<sup>rd</sup> International Letter Writing Competition which will run from 22<sup>nd</sup> January to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2024.

The theme for this year's competition is "At 150 years old, the UPU has served people around the world for more than eight generations. The world has changed enormously since then. Write a letter to future generations about the world you hope they inherit".

The best composition will be submitted to UPU by 5<sup>th</sup> May 2024, to compete at the international level.

Malawi is a member of UPU, which is a specialized agency of the United Nations that coordinates postal policies and systems around the world.

Thirteen-year-old Claire from Kenya was the winner of the  $52^{nd}$  International Letter Writing Competition.

### The objective of the Competition

The Letter-Writing Competition is aimed at encouraging young writers to express creativity and refine their language skills in the form of a letter that is written in line with the International Letter Writing Competition's annual theme. The Competition also aims to bring out innovative thinking which is inherent in all children about the way they perceive the world.

## **Eligibility**

- ➤ Citizens of Malawi aged between 9 and 15 years
- Primary and Secondary School Learners from any school in Malawi
- Not a previous winner of the same competition
- > Not related to MACRA member of staff

## Guidelines:

- > The letter must be in **English**.
- An applicant is only allowed to submit one letter.
- The letter must be handwritten with no more than 1000 words.

- Entries <u>must</u> have a stamp from their respective school.
- Entries must ensure that the <u>name and address of each entrant are indicated in the cover</u> letter and not on the actual letter.
- Entries <u>must</u> provide their name, date of birth, address, telephone number, and contact email address on the <u>cover letter</u>.
- Entries must be submitted by 31st March 2024.

## Prizes:

 $1^{st}$  Prize: Laptop, a gold medal, a dictionary, a mathematical instrument, a box of writing

materials, and 10 notebooks.

2<sup>nd</sup> Prize: Laptop, silver medal, a Mathematical instrument and 5 notebooks.

3<sup>rd</sup> Prize: Laptop, bronze medal, and 5 notebooks.
